<sup>1</sup> Students entering UHP after 2020 with 30+ credits will be placed on an Advanced Entry track, reducing total required credits to 17 (entering with 30-59 credits) or 14 (entering with 60+ credits).

<sup>2</sup> Unless otherwise noted, all courses can be taken either fall or spring semester of the year indicated.

<sup>3</sup> 2000-level honors sections offered through other departments such as WRDS 2102-H and ECON 2101-H may also count as lower division honors electives.

<sup>4</sup> Students studying abroad may request honors equivalency credits for one honors elective; students completing dual honors may count one 3000 or 4000-level course as an honors elective. Request credit for both on the UHP Canvas page, Curriculum tile.

### Additional requirements for graduating with honors:

- Must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0, and 3.2 GPA in honors coursework. Must also maintain good standing in UHP.
- Must complete Application to Candidacy process for graduating with honors, as directed by the Honors College.
