BUSINESS HONORS

PROGRAM



The Business Honors Program is a challenging plan of study designed to prepare you for your future. Members of BHP participate in stimulating coursework, leadership activities, career-building exercises, and community endeavors designed to help students reach their career goals. Honors classes are kept small to facilitate faculty and student interaction. Upon completion of the program, students graduate with an Honors in Business distinction.







ELIGIBILITY

- Students can join as entering freshmen or as rising sophomores or juniors.
- Students must have a minimum 3.5 GPA, along with competitive SAT/ACT scores and class standing equivalents.
- Qualifying credentials include proven academic excellence, demonstrated leadership, and commitment to community service.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Students are expected to enroll in all honors classes offered, including a capstone honors experience.
- Members must participate in an internship or study abroad experience.
- Students must maintain a cumulative 3.5 GPA.
- Additional BHP activities include: community service, social events, and an average of two professional meetings per month.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Acceptance into the Business Honors Program is a highly competitive process. For upcoming deadlines or to submit an online application visit bhp.uncc.edu.

In addition to submitting an application, students must submit two letters of recommendation from instructors or counselors. It is highly recommended that students apply to the program prior to their first semester of study, as available space in the program diminishes after the freshman year. A resume submitted at the time of application detailing demonstrated leadership, academic potential, and community service is also recommended.
